Smarter Balanced assessments measure a student's achievement of the Connecticut Core Standards in English language arts/literacy and mathematics. These standards define learning expectations for what students should know and be able to do at each grade level. The Connecticut Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment is only one indicator of a student's performance. These results should be used along with other information, such as classwork and other tests, when making educational decisions.

It is an example of a Grade 5 English language arts/literacy report. Scale Scores and Achievement Levels vary by grade and content area.
